AMIS-Connect enables timely delivery of information to farmers through their mobile phones. It is fully integrated with AMIS-Tobacco, a web-based Agriculture Management Information System which tracks tobacco crop cycle activities from beginning to end. Expensive or complicated smartphones are not required – a basic mobile phone that can send and receive text messages is all that is needed to experience the benefits of AMIS-Connect.





AMIS-Connect improves communication

Out in the field, it is easy for farmers to feel isolated from their organisations. Communicating with farmers can involve long hours and travel to many areas. With AMIS-Connect, getting announcements, notices and other information to farmers is as easy as writing an e-mail. Each farmer with a mobile number who is registered in AMIS-Tobacco can be reached instantly. Through their mobile phones, farmers can access information from AMIS-Tobacco such as the price of a bag of fertilizer or their own statement balance.

Farmers can receive information directly from AMIS-Tobacco as easily as checking remaining credit or call time. Farmers can access the following information on demand:


- Prices of approved inputs fertilizers, crop protective agents, packaging materials, and other farm equipment.
- Sale prices of tobacco by variety and grade.
- The farmer's own statement balance of tobacco sold less cost of inputs received.

Stakeholder organizations can send information directly to farmers registered in AMIS-Tobacco. Through the web-based Communication Centre of AMIS-Connect, stakeholders can broadcast SMS text messages to their contracted farmers, by group or individually. Stakeholders who can take advantage of AMIS-Connect include:

- Government bodies responsible for agriculture.
- Tobacco growers organisations, cooperatives or unions.
- Financial institutions.
- Multinational buyers.
- Product manufacturers.
